

RESOLUTION 21-R__

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A KEEP AMERICA BEAUTIFUL (KAB) COMMUNITY GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN KEEP AMERICA BEAUTIFUL (KAB) AND THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Keep American Beautiful (KAB), in partnership with its sponsors, Altria, Santa Fe Natural Tobacco Company, and RAI Services, is willing to enter into a Grant Agreement to provide resources to the City to implement a Cigarette Litter Prevention Program (CLPP) project; and

WHEREAS, this Grant Agreement, effective July 1, 2021, is entered into to confirm the parties' understanding of the services and benefits as described in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the description of grant activities shall set forth relevant background information about the City, key performance indicators for goals aligned to the purpose of this Agreement, and any additional commitments of the parties; and

WHEREAS, KAB will provide a cash award of \$15,000 in two installment payments, seventy percent (70%), \$10,500, within thirty (30) days of receiving an executed Agreement; and the remaining thirty percent (30%), \$4,500, upon the acceptance of a final CLPP grant project report; and

WHEREAS, KAB and the City desire to enter into the KAB Community Grant Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that the parties may enter into the Agreement as it serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
