


Idea 10: Temporary Celebration

This installation should be done in a prominent area, such as the Civic Center and should last for several months. A budget of \$150,000 or more should be considered based on available funds.

Temporary Public Art Installation

Idea 10 from the Art in Public Places Plan:

- Envisioned as a \$150,000 Budget
- Last for Several Months
- Local & Regional Draw
- Install done at the Civic Center

Temporary Public Art Installation

Process:

- Reached out to Amigo Amigo who we previously talked with for potential installation
- Offered 9 Pieces that fit our needs
- Selection Panel recommended a piece that fits our needs and fits into the space
- The most affordable at \$43,035
- Additional shipping cost of \$22,714
- Total Budget: \$65,749

Install:

- They provide on the ground support
- We provide 5 staff
- 2 day install
- Coordinating with the Events Center

Temporary Public Art Installation

Duration:

- Intended to be in place December 18th January 25th
- Will be installed for up to 6 weeks
- Coordinating with partners to monitor the piece and have security cameras in place at the selected location
