

ORDINANCE 24-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, REZONING APPROXIMATELY 0.56-ACRES OF LAND, LOCATED SOUTH OF CROSTOWN PARKWAY, ON THE WEST SIDE OF SW BAYSHORE BOULEVARD, FROM PROFESSIONAL (P) ZONING DISTRICT TO SERVICE COMMERCIAL (CS), FOR PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS PORT ST. LUCIE SECTION THIRTEEN, BLOCK 621, LOTS 5 AND 6; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (P24-115)

WHEREAS, Vlada Peterka, seeks to rezone approximately 0.56-acres of land located south of Crosstown Parkway, on the west side of SW Bayshore Boulevard, and within the City of Port St. Lucie, from Professional (P) Zoning District to Service Commercial (CS) Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the proposed zoning is consistent with all applicable elements of the City’s adopted Comprehensive Plan and complies with the City’s Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie Planning and Zoning Board held a public hearing on September 5, 2024, to consider the rezoning application (P24-115), notice of said hearing to adjoining property owners for a radius of seven hundred fifty (750) feet having been given and advertising of public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on September 23, 2024, to consider the rezoning application (P24-115), advertising of the public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the rezoning application (P24-115) based on competent and substantial evidence and the City Council has determined to rezone the property legally described as Port St. Lucie Section Thirteen, Block 621, Lots 5 and 6, as recorded in Plat Book 13, Page 4, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

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Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, hereby adopts and ratifies those matters as set forth in the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. The property is located south of Crosstown Parkway, on the west side of SW Bayshore Boulevard, and legally described as Port St. Lucie Section Thirteen, Block 621, Lots 5 and 6, as recorded in Plat Book 13, Page 4, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, is hereby rezoned from Professional (P) Zoning District to Service Commercial (CS) Zoning District.

Section 3. Conflict. If any ordinance, or parts of ordinances, or if any sections, or parts of sections, of the ordinances of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are in conflict herewith, this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its final adoption.
