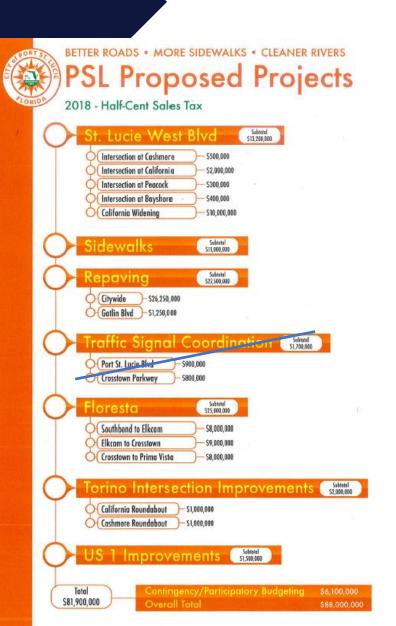

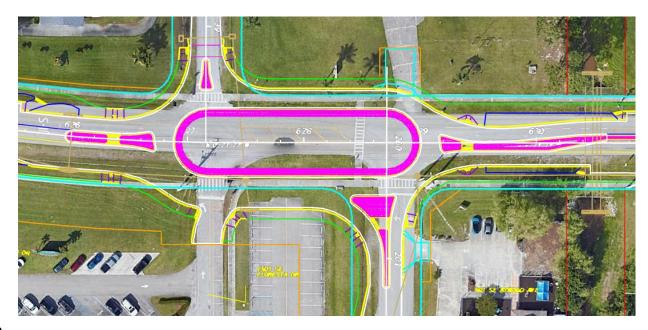

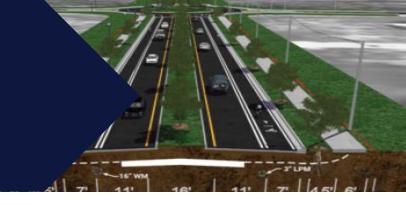




FLORESTA DRIVE PHASES 2 & 3

- Phases 2 and 3 have now been split into independent projects.
- ➤ Phase 2 construction began September 26 with clearing and underground utility work.
- Clearing at Thornhill Pond has been placed on hold pending relocation of Gopher Tortoises
- Construction of Phase 3 is anticipated to begin in the Fall of 2024.
- ➤ Based upon revised revenue projections and construction costs estimates, it is currently estimated that all approved Sales Tax funded projects will be completed. This is subject to change as construction costs continue to rise.

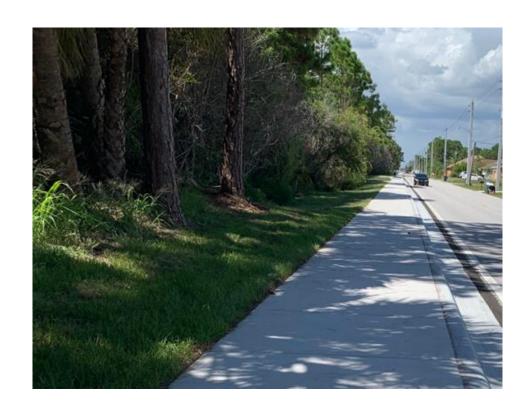

Project Progress:

The seventeen and three-tenths (17.3) miles scheduled to be repaved in FY 21/22 utilizing \$1,600,000 in Sales Tax funding have been completed.

Crosstown Parkway

Completed in May 2020. Project was funded by savings from the Crosstown Parkway Extension project.

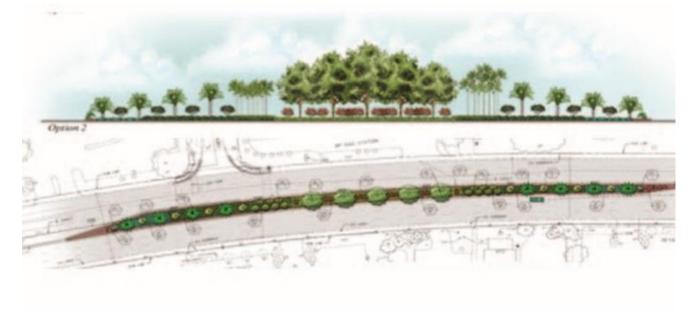
Port St. Lucie Blvd. (Gatlin Boulevard to Gowin Drive)

- ➤ Project is bond funded and has been removed from the Sales Tax Projects list. Budget of \$900,000 will be utilized to cover other project cost increases.
- ➤ Installation of new equipment occurred in July and August.
- Following data collection in September, the system in now partially operational. Staff is continuing to monitor and make adjustments as necessary.

US 1 IMPROVEMENTS



- Funded the portion of landscaping within the US 1 and Crosstown Parkway Intersection Improvements as part of the Crosstown Parkway Extension project
- ➤ US 1 Landscaping and Irrigation Improvements pre-bid meeting will be held on October 11 to provide an overview of the project. Project is currently advertised with a bid opening on November 3. Anticipate project getting underway in January 2023.

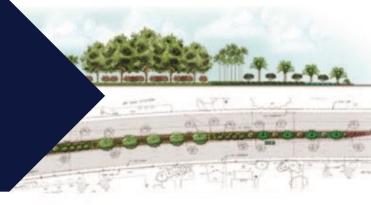

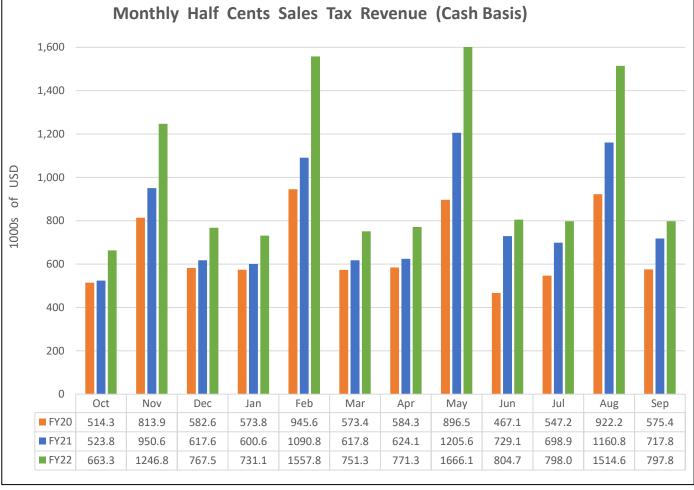
