A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE ST. LUCIE RIVER/C-23 WATER QUALITY PROJECT – AREAS 5 AND 6; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) awarded federal funds for the St. Lucie River/C-23 Water Quality Project for Areas 5 and 6 via Agreement number NF090 ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the DEP and the City desire to enter into the Grant Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that the parties may enter into the Agreement as it serves a public purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1</u>. <u>Ratification of Recitals</u>. The City Council hereby adopts and ratifies those matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.
- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Authorization</u>. The City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Grant Agreement and any other documents related to execute and perform the work required to complete this Project.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to all other persons as directed by the City Council.
- <u>Section 4</u>. <u>Conflict.</u> If any Resolution, or parts of any Resolution, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.
- Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is held to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect and this Resolution shall nevertheless stand and be construed as if the illegal or invalid part or portion had not been included herein.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
