Ms. Alvarez:

I represent Shivam Properties LLC, the owner of 155 SW Peacock Blvd., regarding the above case number and hearing set for June 25, 2025. The violation results from unpermitted work due to the Owner being misled by an unlicensed contractor. On March 21, 2025, the Owner entered into a joint stipulation of settlement in lieu of enforcement hearing giving the Owner until June 24th to resolve the violation. After a diligent search for licensed contractor, the Owner retained River Ridge Renovations LLC. RRR finalized the exterior permit and it was issued on May 30th. The interior permit was applied for on June 6th, but is still pending plan review. After speaking with Ms. Feilner, the interior permit will likely not be issued before June 24th despite the Owner and RRR's diligent efforts, and a planned meeting for June 20th. Mr. LaPonza and I spoke today, and he confirmed that he has observed the Owner's efforts to come into compliance. In this regard, I was hoping there was a way to have the June 25th hearing continued for 90 days to allow for the Owner to finalize the interior permit, or if that is not possible, I was hoping there is an option for me to appear at the June 25th hearing via Zoom. I appreciate your time and look forward to receiving your feedback.
