- No additional roadway requirements are triggered at this time.
- DRI requirement for 2 lanes of Riverland Blvd. (N/S B) from Discovery to E/W 3 is not triggered until either 5,660 dwelling unit COs or 6,305 Total Net External PM Peak Hour trips whichever comes later.
- At this time, Riverland is constructing more roadway than the DRI currently requires.
