A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE SETTLEMENT OF A CLAIM AGAINST THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a claim against the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida ("City") arose from a sewage pump failure near claimant Lindsay Johnson's home which occurred on or about April 9, 2024 ("Incident"); and

WHEREAS, the Incident resulted in injury to claimant's person and/or property; and

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the submitted claim, the City accepted liability based upon the unique facts and circumstances; and

WHEREAS, after extensive negotiation, the parties have agreed to terms and conditions which will fully and finally settle the claim; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution authorizes the settlement of the claim in the total amount of \$195,592.32 in exchange for claimant executing a General Release in substantially the same form as the attached Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the settlement of this claim serves a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2. Conflict.</u> If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
