A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL SUBDIVISION PLAT FOR PORT ST. LUCIE SECTION 25, REPLAT OF LOT 11, BLOCK 24, WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF SLALANI LLC; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by the owner, Slalani LLC, to approve and accept the preliminary and final subdivision plat with no construction plans titled Port St. Lucie Section 25, Replat of Lot 11, Block 24 (P21-102), within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the plat conforms to Section 156, Port St. Lucie City Code, and meets all State requirements for such plats; and

WHEREAS, the Site Plan Review Committee, on May 26, 2021, recommended approval of the preliminary and final subdivision plat (P21-102).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. That the City Council hereby approves the preliminary and final subdivision plat titled Port St. Lucie Section 25, Replat of Lot 11, Block 24 (P21-102) located within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, said preliminary and final plat being offered by Slalani LLC, as the owner and title holder of said property and as prepared by Michael T. Owen, as designated on the attached said Plat.

Section 3. That the Vice Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are hereby authorized to countersign the said plat so it may be properly recorded in the public records of St. Lucie County, Florida.

Section 4. Conflicts. If any Resolution, or parts of any Resolution, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or
