AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CELL TOWER SITE LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE AND GRAINCOMM I, LLC, A DELAWARE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, FOR CONTINUED USE OF EXISTING TELECOMMUNICATION TOWER LOCATED AT 1449 SW APACHE AVE, PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie ("City") owns and operates a cell tower facility located at 1449 SW Apache Ave, Port St. Lucie, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City deems it to be in the best interest of the City to lease said property to GrainComm I, LLC ("GrainComm") to provide City residents with improved cell tower service and reception and to provide reception service to the City's police department and other emergency efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to execute a site lease amendment ("Site Lease Amendment") in substantially the same form as attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Ratification of Recitals.</u> The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager, or his designees, are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Site Lease Amendment in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and to take any and all necessary actions required to effectuate the terms of the Site Lease Amendment.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Conflict.</u> If any ordinances, or parts of ordinances, are in conflict herewith this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final adoption on second reading.
