RE: Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Funding Award

Dear Mayor Martin:

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) is pleased to inform you that the City of Port St. Lucie has been awarded \$423,707 through the CDBG-CV program for the project outlined in the City of Port St. Lucie CDBG-CV application.

The City of Port St. Lucie may begin incurring administrative costs for the approved CDBG-CV project in accordance with 24 C.F.R. Part 58. Administrative costs may not exceed \$5,000 until further authorized by DEO. The City is not authorized to conduct non-administrative activities until the City has received authorization from DEO.

The grant award is effective on March 1, 2022, but is contingent upon mutual execution of the subgrant agreement with DEO. Reimbursements may not be submitted to DEO until after execution of the City's subgrant agreement with DEO.
