

ORDINANCE 22-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, REZONING A 36.04-ACRE PROPERTY LOCATED SOUTH OF BECKER ROAD AND WEST OF SW VILLAGE PARKWAY, FROM SLC AGRICULTURAL 5 (SLC AG-5) ZONING DISTRICT TO GENERAL USE (GU) ZONING DISTRICT FOR PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS SOUTHERN GROVE REPLAT NO. 30, TRACT F (P23-104); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Mattamy Palm Beach LLC, seeks to rezone a 36.04-acre property located, South of Becker Road and West of SW Village Parkway, and within the City of Port St. Lucie, from SLC Agricultural 5 (SLC AG-5) Zoning District to General Use (GU) Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the proposed zoning is consistent with all applicable elements of the City’s adopted Comprehensive Plan and complies with the City’s Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie Planning and Zoning Board held a public hearing on August 1, 2023 to consider the rezoning application (P23-104), notice of said hearing to adjoining property owners for a radius of seven hundred and fifty (750) feet having been given and advertising of public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on September 11, 2023, to consider the rezoning application (P23-104), advertising of the public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the rezoning application (P23-104) based on substantial and competent evidence and the City Council has determined to rezone the property legally described as Southern Grove Replat No. 30, Tract F, as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, hereby adopts and ratifies those matters as set forth in the foregoing recitals.

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Section 2. That the property located, South of Becker Road and West of SW Village Parkway, and legally described as Southern Grove Replat No. 30, Tract F, be rezoned from SLC Agricultural 5 (SLC AG-5) Zoning District to General Use (GU) Zoning District; and

Section 3. Conflict. If any ordinance, or parts of ordinances, or if any sections, or parts of sections, of the ordinances of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are in conflict herewith, this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its final adoption.
