# Methodology/Approach



Bowman will be responsible for overseeing, managing and conducting all surveying activities under this contract for the City. Our meticulous project management procedures will ensure that all tasks assigned by the City will be successfully delivered on time and within budget. Our team is consistently relied upon by public sector clients to provide all types of surveys. When a project has been identified and assigned to Bowman, Rick will schedule another meeting to discuss the scope of the project. This meeting may take place in person, video meeting (Zoom, Teams, etc.), or at the survey site, depending

on which option best suits the City. If applicable, Rick will discuss utilizing our state-of-the-art technology "toolbox" to provide a cost effective, time saving alternative to complete the survey. ## **Investigative/Research Phase**

Providing the research prior to the proposal preparation will give us a clear understanding of the magnitude of the project. A detailed cost-effective proposal will be prepared for the City with an exhibit designating the survey area, a labor/fee spreadsheet and a schedule for completion. - Survey control point description sheets.
- · .kmz file showing the survey location.

The field survey will then commence within one week of execution of the work order. The field crew methodically goes step-by-step according to the written instructions. Our party chiefs working on Port St. Lucie projects all have 20 plus years of field experience. Field data is sent to the office during and after the workday. All our field crews are equipped with laptop computers with a Wi-Fi connection, giving us the ability to send and receive data in "real time". The ability to instantly transfer data keeps projects moving forward and gives our professional staff the ability to identify potential problems or risks early and correct them before they happen. QA/QC doesn't start at the end of the project it is a continuous process. Throughout each project's life cycle, Rick will send detailed status reports to the City's project manager every Monday. Meetings or conference calls with all stakeholders will take place as needed. Invoices will be sent according to the agreed-upon billing schedule.

#### Drafting

Our survey technicians that will be servicing this contract are second to none. They each have over 15 years of experience survey drafting. Based on the scope of work, standards checklists (see following page) will be tailored to exactly match the needs of each project, and for everyone involved with the project.
