A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NAME OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE BUDGET ADVISORY COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida ("City") duly approved and adopted Resolution 17-R40 on June 26, 2017, which served to establish and organize the City of Port St. Lucie Budget Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, has determined that there is a need for citizen input into the budgetary process to promote the health, safety, financial soundness and general welfare of the City of Port St. Lucie; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie determined at the February 22, 2023 City Council Workshop that there is a need for an amendment to Resolution 17-R40 to rename the City of Port St. Lucie Budget Advisory Committee to provide greater clarity to the public on the Committee's role; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Ratification of Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Name Change</u>. The City of Port St. Lucie Budget Advisory Committee shall be named The City of Port St. Lucie Citizens Advisory Committee going forward;

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Conflict</u>. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
