

ORDINANCE -23\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE 2022-23 BUDGET BY INSERTING THEREIN A SCHEDULE CONSISTING OF EIGHT (8) PAGES, DESIGNATED AS 2022-23 BUDGET AMENDMENT NO. 1, WHICH SCHEDULE PROVIDES FOR AN INCREASE AND/OR DECREASE IN APPROPRIATIONS IN THE VARIOUS LINE ITEMS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance 21-88, adopted on September 26, 2022 and becoming effective on October 1, 2022, the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, adopted the Budget of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, for the Fiscal Year commencing October 1, 2022 and concluding September 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby desires to amend the Budget of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida to provide for an increase and/or decrease in various line items.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Approval of Budget Amendment No. 1. The Budget of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, is hereby amended by increasing and/or decreasing various line items, as is more fully set forth in the schedule consisting of eight (8) pages which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, and which amendment shall be known as Budget Amendment No. 1.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, hereby instructs and directs the City Manager and the OMB Budget Director to transfer said funds to specified accounts, thereby increasing and/or decreasing the various line items, in conformity with the schedule attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. Conflict. If any ordinances, or parts of ordinances, are in conflict herewith, this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final adoption on second reading.
