

# Exhibit A

## Updates to Chapter 155 are listed below for clarification

- ◆ Spelling updates
- ◆ Clarifying language of existing code and pictural descriptions
- ◆ Removal of language to the Building code requirements so that the sign code does not conflict with any changes or requirements of the Building Code.
- ◆ Addition of Business frontage determination for clarity and allowing the best use of a building for signage opportunity.
- ◆ Master Sign Program language updated for simplification.
- ◆ Removal of content-based code.
- ◆ Update to the temporary sign regulations for setbacks. The update reduces the setback for signs over five feet in height from ten feet down to five feet. The update permits any sign less than five feet in height to be setback three feet. It also removes a separation of requirements between zoning districts.
- ◆ A change was made for Building Identification signs so that strip retail buildings may display the Building sign without loosing the right for tenants to have their business signage.
- ◆ Addition of Public Electronic message monument signs.
