

**RESOLUTION 26-R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONCERNING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON THE EAST SIDE OF NORTHWEST VOLUCIA DRIVE FROM NORTHWEST EAST TORINO PARKWAY TO WEST BLANTON BOULEVARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Port St. Lucie requested funding assistance from the State of Florida Department of Transportation (“FDOT”) for the construction of sidewalk improvements on the east side of Northwest Volucia Drive from Northwest East Torino Parkway to West Blanton Boulevard (hereinafter referred to as the “Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the draft Local Agency Program (LAP) agreement estimates the cost of the Project at \$1,534,515.00, which includes approximately \$255,752.24 in required contingency; and a portion of the financing of the Project will be provided through the use of federal funds totaling approximately \$744,062.00, which will be made available to the City as reimbursement for the costs associated with the participating construction activities for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms and conditions upon which the Federal funding assistance will be provided and the understandings as to the manner in which the City will undertake and complete the Project are formalized in the attached Local Agency Program (“LAP”) Agreement, which is incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to pursue the Project, which shall be completed on or before June 30, 2027, unless otherwise extended, and accept the funding assistance and enter into the LAP Agreement with FDOT.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, THAT:**

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Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into, execute and deliver to FDOT the LAP Agreement, in substantially the same form that is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" to this Resolution, and such other documents necessary to implement the terms of said Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager and City Engineer, and their designees, are hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the LAP Agreement, and accomplish the purposes set forth therein.

Section 4. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
