


Del Webb at Tradition Plat No. 5A Final Subdivision Plat

The Site Plan Review Committee recommended approval of the final subdivision plat and construction plans at their October 27, 2021 meeting.





IMPACTS AND FINDINGS

CONCURRENCY REVIEW (CHAPTER 160)

The project has been reviewed for compliance with the Southern Grove DRI development order and Chapter 160, City Code, regarding provision of adequate public facilities and documented as follows:

	The City of Port St. Lucie Utility Systems Department will
	provide water and sewer service. The construction plans
Sanitary Sewer and Potable Water	include the necessary water and sewer extensions to serve
Facilities	the development. A developer's agreement with the City
	Utilities Department, that is consistent with the adopted level
	of service, is required prior to issuance of building permits.
	The applicant has submitted a trip generation analysis that
	indicates that this project will generate 1,213 average daily
Traffic Circulation	trips and 121 pm peak hour trips. Per the Southern Grove
	DRI development order, the DRI Biennial Report shall include
	a cumulative calculation of the trip generation for all
	approved development. Development order conditions are
	evaluated using the trip generation analyses to determine
	triggering of any transportation conditions. Public Works has
	reviewed the traffic analysis and the memo is attached.
	Per the DRI development order, a plan for the provision of
Parks and Recreation Facilities	neighborhood and community recreational sites and facilities
	has been submitted.
Stormwater Management Facilities	The project includes a paving and drainage plan that is in
Stormwater Management racinties	compliance with the adopted level of service.
	Solid waste impacts are measured and planned based on

	Per Policy 2.4.2 of the City's Comprehensive Plan, this
Public School Concurrency Analysis	development will be exempt from public school concurrency,
	since it is proposed to be an age restricted community.

NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION (CHAPTER 157)

The project has been reviewed for compliance with the requirements of Chapter 157, Natural Resource Protection Code, and documented as follows:

Native Habitat/Tree Protection: The plat contains no upland preserve or wetland conservation areas.

Wildlife Protection: Listed species surveys were required prior to clearing.

OTHER

<u>Fire District:</u> The access location (external and internal) has been reviewed by the Fire District for safety purposes.

<u>Public Art (Chapter 162):</u> The public art requirement for this project has been satisfied by the installation of a sculpture at the southwest corner of E/W 3 and Village Parkway.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Site Plan Review Committee recommended approval of the final subdivision plat and construction plans at their meeting of October 27, 2021.
