Project Overview

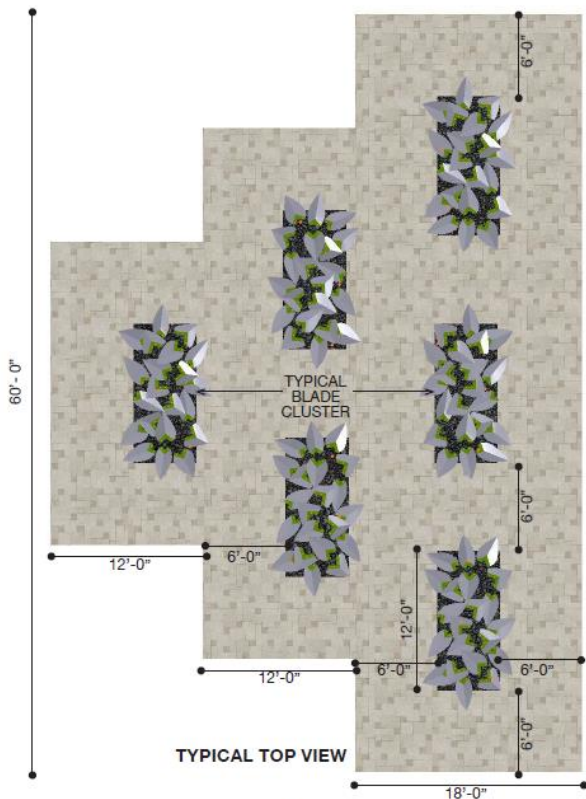
Approval

- Concept features twelve sculptural blades incorporating nineteen species of ladybugs. Proposal

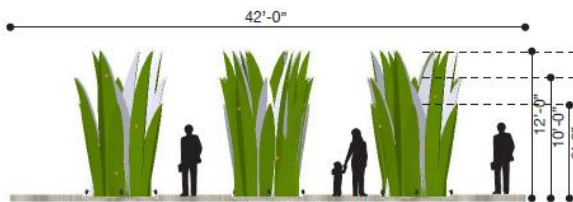
Proposal

- New proposed site is in an open space tract between a wetland and Wylder Parkway.

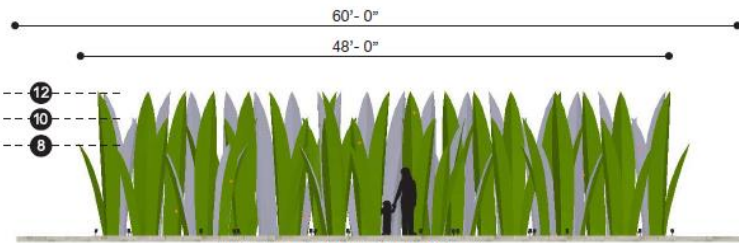

TYPICAL TOP VIEW

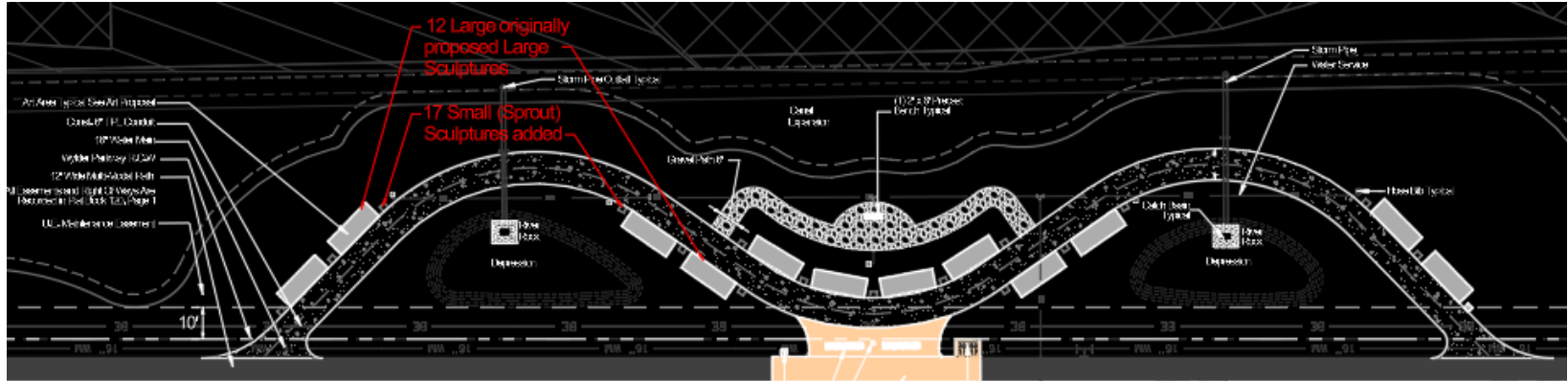


TYPICAL SIDE VIEW

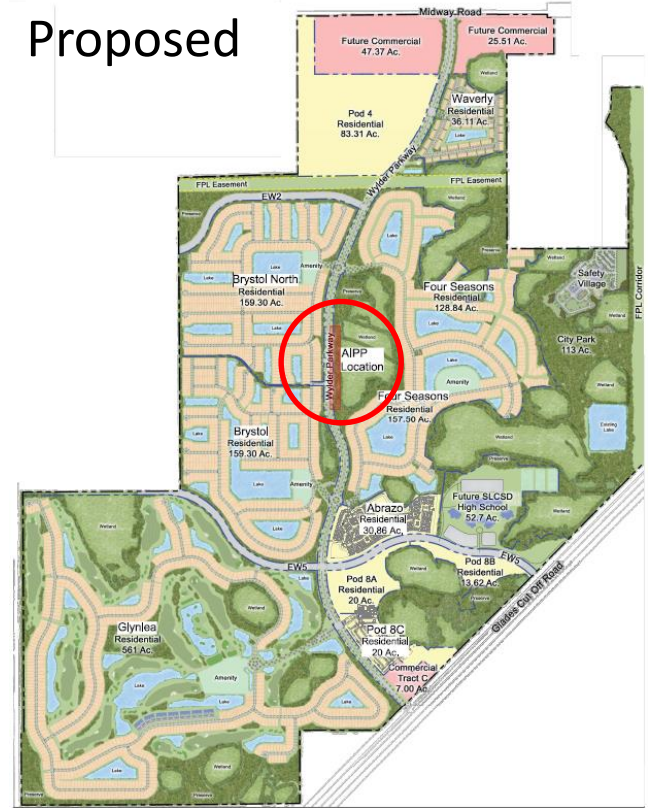
