All bids must be entered in the above described auction website. The City shall in no way be responsible for any delays arising from

or caused by any occurrence whatsoever in its receipt of any bids after the Auction Due Date and Time. No exceptions will be made.

E-Bidding will be done through a secure locked box through the auction website. The Bidder's E-Bid may be changed at the Bidder's discretion until the Auction Due Date and Time is reached. The Bidder will no longer be allowed to change or have access to the electronic bid submittal after the Auction Due Date and Time as the City will open all bids on said date. Bids received after the time set for the bid opening will be rejected and returned unopened. The City of Port St. Lucie reserves the right to waive any and all informalities, to reject all bids, or accept any bid as deemed to be in the City's best interest. All bidders must agree to enter into a Sale and Purchase Agreement within seven (7) days of City Council approval date. All bids will be considered binding on the bidder for a period of ninety (90) days after the date of bid opening.
