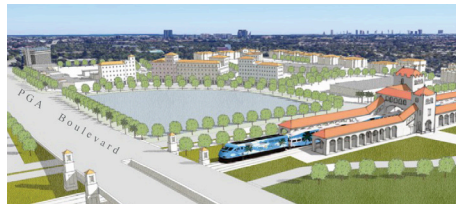

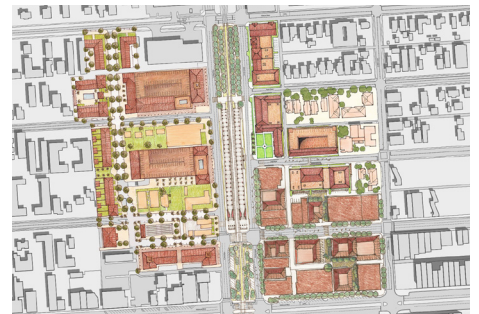

Potential new passenger train station and proposed new zoning required a new strategic approach. The project proposes incentivized building techniques, right of way improvements, complete street design, and placement of a new train station.



Through charrette facilitation and the development of a station area master plan, the city is now primed to set forth development conditions in advance of a future train station and to enhance the city's redevelopment efforts.

South Dixie Corridor Master Plan
