A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE FINAL PLAT WITH CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR MATTAMY AT SOUTHERN GROVE PLAT NO. 1 (P19-088) WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, ON THE REQUEST OF MATTAMY PALM BEACH, LLC; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by the owner, Mattamy Palm Beach, LLC, to approve and accept the final plat titled Mattamy at Southern Grove Plat No. 1, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and

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Section 3. Conflict. If any resolution, or parts of any resolution, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
